What is a digital leader?

- Digital natives vs Digital immigrants
- He has the ICT skills and competences
- A digital leader has been identified for some skills he/she has by teachers and given some time and opportunities to train himself and others
- He needs to be inspiring / motivating / creative
- He must be willing to experiment and to advance
- Teach the students and teachers as well

STEPS (cont.)

- “Logistics”:
 - Finding time
 - Space
 - Designing training
 - Staff involved
- Digital leaders should have opportunities to **design their own learning**
- Sharing, reflecting, validating
- Recruiting new digital leaders (never-ending cycle)
